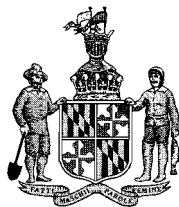

At the request of William Gruhn, I am responding to your correspondence dated September 25, 2011. On July 21, 2011, we wrote to you to mediate a complaint that we received from a Maryland consumer, Mark Sapperstein. Based on the information contained in that complaint, it appears as if you have attempted to negotiate payments from Mr. Sapperstein equaling tens of thousands to millions of dollars in return for your agreement to cease publishing accusations about Mr. Sapperstein that do not appear to be supported by fact (for example, that Mr. Sapperstein is the head of a crime syndicate).


The purpose of our letter was to mediate Mr. Sapperstein's complaint pursuant to our statutory authority under the Maryland Consumer Protection Act, Md. Code Ann., Com. Law §§ 13-101 through 13-501. Our letter did not initiate any legal proceeding against you. However, if we are to take any legal action against you in this matter, such an action would be filed in Maryland because part of the complained of conduct occurred in Maryland and such an action would be taken to enforce a Maryland statute.

Finally, neither I nor Mr. Ziperman are licensed to practice law in Florida. I trust this addresses the concerns that you raised in your letter. Please advise me whether you are interested in mediation of Mr. Sapperstein's complaint.

Thank you for your attention to this matter.
